

Adoption Medical Paperwork – Checklist

Form Needed	Information	Tick when completed
Form M – and B Obstetrics/Neonatal Form	These forms are together as one form You must put Dr Rao's details on the form and then send it to Dr Drew's secretary at the Manor Hospital and they will forward it to Dr Rao. This must be done in good time for the medical.	
Consent Form	Parental consent needs to be signed and a copy needs to be attached to all forms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Child's Initial Health Assessment Form. To obtain health information relating to a child or young person: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a birth parent with parental responsibility should sign Part B, or - another adult, or a person representing an agency, with parental responsibility, should sign Part D • Parental Health Form To obtain health information relating to a birth parent: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Each birth parent should sign a separate form for each child becoming looked after - The birth parent should sign Part B • M and B Neonatal and Obstetric Forms (as above) 	
Form PH – Parental Health history form	Each Parent to Complete the form and sign State clearly on this form if they refuse to complete it	
Form IHA - C Initial Health Assessment Form	Social Worker and child's details to be filled in and the rest left blank for the medical. Form C is for child aged 0-9 years. Consent must be signed by parent or if on Interim/Full Care Order and parent does not sign then social worker must sign	
Foster Carer Evaluation of Child Form	Foster carer to be sent this form by you and they have to complete it and return it to you for the medical.	
Background Information Form	Social Worker to complete and include details of why child is looked after.	

- You need to book the adoption Medical 6 weeks prior to you attending adoption panel.
- The above forms need to be sent before the Medical to Dr Rao's secretary **Sam Perry at Blakenhall Village Centre, Thames Road, Blakenhall, Walsall. WS3 1LZ.**
- Keep a copy of each completed form on the child's file
- The Social Worker (who is allocated) must attend the medical with the foster carer and the child
- The Foster carer needs to bring the red book
- Also bring any school reports and any other reports such as Psychological or Psychiatric Assessments
